Aled Davies, a graduate of the University of California, San Diego has been named one of the nation's most promising actors by Theater World in its prestigious annual awards issue.

He recently completed a tour of the nation with The Acting Company in "Orchards," a group of plays based on the short stories of Russian author Anton Chekhov. The touring repertory company is made up of graduates of The Juilliard School and other widely respected acting programs.

Davies, who delivered a 40-minute monologue in one of the "Orchards" plays adapted by Spaulding Gray, received a masters of fine arts degree from UCSD's Department of Theatre in 1984.
