

Niki-Kai Opera Company presents comic opera

The Niki-Kai Opera Company, Tokyo, presented by the Committee for Arts aid Lectures, University of California, San Diego, will be performing "The Marriage Contest," a comic opera in two acts. The performance is set for Thursday, October 10, in Sherwood Hall, La Jolla, at 8:30 p.m.

"The Marriage Contest" describes the quixotic ambitions of three young swains competing for the hand of the very marriageable Sakuhanna. A series of trials is set by Sakuhanna's father to prove which suitor will be the most acceptable, and the results are an enchanting deviation from a timeless plot.

The opera will be performed in Japanese and is presented under the auspices of the Japan America Society of Los Angeles, co-sponsored with the Intercampus Cultural Exchange Committee of the University of California. General admission tickets are \$4.00, UCSD student tickets, \$1.00.
