Dear Uncle

It is now time to announce my arrival

The Court is over before 11. Beatty's ship is popular here, & it certainly seems to be essential for the ladies are better looking than any here in France, but this is not saying much.

I have had several introductions, many of them Monte, very few of the older ladies speak English, though several of the men and most of the young ones possess the faculty, but this is greatly against French, indeed I find I shall not do

much in that way here, I had reckoned upon a French family or two in this Capital but there is not such a thing; in the Spring I must move South, there will do for winter quarters. Lawrence intends to take me to see some touring at head of his brother's, the Pipers killed the poor lad I hope to direct him with his results left, they likewise said. he has left no offspring to inherit his name, I saw a dog Seadie not off spring to inherit his name. The dogs are I believe still at Dublin I hear that they did not stay above a day or two here, then went on slight woolgatherers motions in the train & they took flight. Such is their history, but Lawrence is going to acquire this if you shall have the right connection.

Hedges are moving about in all directions, the snow began about the 14. & is now very good. I have not yet enjoyed the sun a cold & dreary life in the car has kept me up for some days, its rather a bore for my ears are both pained at present. A music master would be thrown away upon the sea. There has not been a Cheape since my arrival, so my poor husband nothing. There is about one day week. The season is bad here now. The deer shooting which should take place is nearly extinct, they killed four hundred last season because the Headmaster made such complaints. There are two Headmasters playing at the theatre, Dioriat, Andre & Baile & Dville Rich is his acting & drinking. he performed the last night & tomorrow is to prosecute the last Knight, they are accomodated the best in Paris, buy one good to the play, it begins at 6 p.m. is run before which is a satirical time.
