PLEASE DISREGARD OUR OCTOBER 21 RELEASE ABOUT THE PRAGUE STRING QUARTET. THE FOLLOWING IS THE CORRECT INFORMATION:

The Vermeer Quartet will perform at 8 p.m. Saturday, November 13, in Mandeville Center Auditorium on the campus of the University of California, San Diego.

The program will include Haydn's "Unfinished" Quartet in B Flat Major, Op. 103; Schumann's Quartet in F Major, Op. 41, No. 2; and Beethoven's Quartet in B Flat Major, Op. 130.

The Vermeer Quartet, founded in 1970 in Marlboro, Vermont, has won wide acclaim from the beginning of its career. Its concerts are divided equally between North America and Europe.

The members of the quartet are violinists Shmuel Ashkenasi and Pierre Menard, violist Bernard Zaslav and cellist Marc Johnson. All are members of the Resident Artists Faculty of Northern Illinois University in DeKalb.

The quartet has participated in most of the important international festivals Spoleto, South Bank, Berlin, Edinburgh, Mostly Mozart, Caramoor, Santa Fe, San Francisco, Casals and others.

The Vermeer Quartet recently performed at Carnegie Hall in a Schubert festival which also featured such artists as Isaac Stern, Pinchas Zukerman and the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra.
