Gulph of California November 20th 1860

Dear Sisters

our sail in sight bound
down the Gulph I have not had any
Opportunity to send you a letter
since leaving Cape Sant Lucas. We
have taken the Coast of Lower California
from Cape Sant Lucas to the River Colorado
found some Islands with some Queros on
know Bound Down on the Mexican
side stop at the George's Islands the
other day and in tending to load the
schooner but it came on a Gale from
the South East was obliged to slip
our Chane and put to sea and
are ~~now~~ bound back to get our Anchor
and finish loading, when I shall get
of this cruise it is hard to say but
I hope before long I am well and
hope this will find you all the same
My Love to Sister Charlott Eliza and
all the Boys and Girls say to Henry
and Edward they must write me
Brendley might send me a Correc-
know and then, if we stop at Guimoes
I will write from there by Over Land

I do not expect to hear from you till
I get back to San Francisco if I should
go back I may be left down here on
some of the Islands or stop at some
place till a ship comes down from
San Francisco I hope they have been
punctual in sending you your money
Capt. Isham is well and sends
his best respects to you all
I must close for the Boat is about
to leave for the Schooner
