REMARKS: 100 students from nations around the world will be moving in to the new International House at UCSD's Pepper Canyon Apartment Complex. UCSD is opening International House to provide a center for students to live and learn in an atmosphere of cultural diversity. Students, scholars and faculty from the U.S. and abroad will come together here to share concerns and perceptions. International House will house 197 residents from 30 different countries. One half of the group are juniors and seniors and one half are graduate and post doctoral students.
