UCSD'S GROVE GALLERY CELEBRATES ITS 10TH BIRTHDAY WITH A SHOW TITLED "HAPPY BIRTHCLAY." FROM APRIL 10-JUNE 14

To help celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Grove Gallery at the University of California, San Diego, 11 ceramicists who have exhibited their work in one and two-person shows in the gallery during the past 10 years will return for a show titled "Happy Birthclay: A Tenth Anniversary Retrospective," from April 10 through June 14.

The gallery will host an artists' reception/birthday party from 6:30-8 p.m. June 5. The public is invited.

The artists and the dates of their previous exhibitions are: Frank Boyden of Otis, Oregon (1987); Cynthia Bringle of Penland, North Carolina (1983); Ron Carlson of Cardiff, California (1986); Philip Cornelius of Pasadena, California (1982); Trine Dixon of Del Mar, California (1987); Ellen Fager of Portland, Oregon (1984); Joanne Hayakawa of San Diego, California (1983); Otto and Vivika Heino of Ojai, California (1982); Paul Soldner of Aspen, Colorado (1985), and Byron Temple of Louisville, Kentucky (1986).

The UCSD Crafts Center, which for years has offered courses in ceramics, photography, basket weaving, music, fiber arts and jewelry making, among others, opened the Grove Gallery in 1982 with a grant from the UCSD Chancellor's Associates.

Originally envisioned as a place for local craftspersons to show their works, the Grove Gallery has broadened its exhibition program to include national artists who create ceramics, sculpture, painting, photographs, jewelry, screened prints, quilts, drawing, and other fine and folk art forms. The gallery has mounted more than 80 exhibitions in the past 10 years.

Gallery hours are Tuesday through Saturday, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Parking permits are required on the UCSD campus and may be purchased at the information pavilions on Northview Drive and Gilman Drive. For information call 534-2021.
