Monday the 14 th , she was released into Mexicali. a and three other women who were released with her pooled their money together and took a bus to Tijuana.
she was severely traumatized by the experience. Her sister says she has serious emotional problems to begin with, now with this experience she has withdrawn even more
One important footnote to all this is that POE on Saturday evening, the same day was detained, to show the INS proof
that she was born in the U.S., including her original birth certificate, but the INS told him
it was too late, and that he should come back Monday. By then been deported to Mexicali.
