Myles has performed throughout the United States and Europe since the mid 1970s. Her poetry collection, "Not Me," was published in 1991 by Semiotext(e) and was nominated for a Lambda Book Award.

Myles' poems have appeared in numerous journals, including the "Kenyon Review," "Outlook," "Ploughshares," and "City Lights." She also works as a playwright, performance artist and a writer of short stories.
