

7,951 graduate and undergraduate students have enrolled in fall quarter classes at UCSD

A total of 7,951 graduate and undergraduate students have enrolled in fall quarter classes at the University of California, San Diego according to the final registration report released by Ronald J. Bowker, Registrar and Admissions Officer at UCSD.

The total is an increase of 882 students over the number officially enrolled during the fall quarter last year. Nearly all of the increase is at the undergraduate level.

The official registration figures are gathered by the Office of the Registrar at the end of the third week of classes for submission to UC President Charles J. Hitch. The report includes the number of lower division and upper division undergraduate students plus all graduate students including those in the School of Medicine and Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

The report lists 6,190 undergraduates, 842 more than last year, enrolled for the fall quarter at UCSD. Revelle College, which began operation in 1964, enrolled 2,661; Muir College, which began three years later, enrolled 2,955; and Third College, beginning its fourth year of operation, enrolled 574.

According to the report, the School of Medicine enrolled 568 students, up 46 from last year. Some 235 of the students are M.D. candidates and 333 are interns or residents.

The Graduate Division enrolled 1,193 students, including 186 at Scripps, about the same number as were enrolled by the division last year.

According to Bowker, UCSD enrolled about 300 more students than were originally included in the long range growth schedule. Host of those 300 are lower division undergraduate students (freshmen and sophomores) while the upper division and graduate numbers are at expected levels.
