Scripps of West Chester, Butler County, Ohio, in consideration of Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars paid by United States Navy the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and wherewith he is fully satisfied, contented and paid, has bargained and sold, and by these presents does bargain, sell, assign and transfer unto the said United States Navy, its successors and assigns ----- the boat "ELLEN BROWNING" together with the engine, anchors, cables, tackle, furniture and all other necessities thereto appertaining and belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said "ELLEN BROWNING" and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said United States Navy ----- to the sole and only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said United States Navy, its successors and assigns -----

Said Edward W. Scripps, for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators covenants with the said United States Navy, its successors and assigns that the said "ELLEN BROWNING" and all the other beforementioned appurtenances are free and clear from all encumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the same against all persons lawfully claiming, or who may claim the whole or any part thereof.

This boat was built by W. C. Crandall, of the Scripps Institution for Biological Research, and paid for out of funds provided by said Edward W. Scripps, for the joint use of said Institution and said Scripps. Said Scripps is ill and unable to attend to business. This Bill of Sale is executed by James G. Scripps, eldest son, Agent and Attorney-in-fact of said Edward W. Scripps, under Power of Attorney, copy whereof is attached to this Bill of Sale. This Bill of Sale, with the Bill of Sale executed on behalf of the Scripps Institution for Biological Research, conveys every interest in said boat "ELLEN BROWNING" and gives full and complete title thereto.
