

## Honorary Alumni present scholarships totaling \$10,000

Twenty scholarships, totaling \$10,000, are being awarded to high school students by the Honorary Alumni of the University of California, San Diego, Charles Catlin, president of the association, announced today.

The scholarships, which will cover at least total freshman fees, have been made possible through the fundraising activities of the Honorary Alumni and subsequent matching of funds by the University Board of Regents.

Two of the scholarships, presented in the name of former Mayor Charles Dail, have been given in honor of his contributions to the University of California, particularly to the San Diego campus. According to Catlin, the Charles Dail scholarships will be annual awards issued to the young man and woman who show the most exceptional promise to the University. Miss Sue Stevens, San Diego, a student at Morse High School and Stephen Hill, San Diego, a student at Will C. Crawford High School, received the current Charles Dail scholarships.

Several other scholarships were presented in the names of contributors to the Honorary Alumni scholarship fund campaign. The students and their scholarships are:
