


Several out transgender students meet

LGBA adds the "T" and officially becomes LGBTA




MK Kaufman – principal member of Queering Gender, first organization that discussed issues related to gender identity at UC San Diego


LGBT Resource Center opens, visible trans presence at grand opening

Registrar begins to accept special requests for name changes


Transgender students are able to live in housing given their current needs, regardless of "official" gender designation on record
