Entry forms for the first Triton Intercollegiate Athletic Association (TIAA) 10,000-meter run, scheduled for 7:30 a.m. Sunday, October 25, at the University of California, San Diego, are available at sporting goods stores throughout San Diego County and at the UC San Diego Department of Physical Education.

Runners will follow UC San Diego's scenic 10-K AAU certified course, a moderately flat layout through the campus and the surrounding eucalyptus groves.

The entry fee is \$6 and includes a T-shirt.

"The TIAA was founded by a group of UCSD athletes concerned with athletics at UCSD," says TIAA president Bob Conlin, a junior majoring in bioengineering. "We formed the club in April of 1981 to try to make UCSD athletics more recognized."

Composed of 85 intercollegiate athletes, the TIAA is involved in several promotion projects. Last June they sponsored the first athletic awards banquet, an effort they hope will become an annual event. UC San Diego offers no athletic scholarships and the athletic program is funded chiefly through student registration fees, which allows for very little money for promotion.
