Cyberspace guru Howard Rheingold, editor of the just published Millennium Whole Earth Catalog: Access to Tools and Ideas for the Twenty-First Century, will come to UCSD Nov. 15 for a noontime book signing at the UCSD Bookstore and an afternoon visit with communication students.

The long-awaited '90s answer to the Whole Earth Catalog published 25 years ago, the Millennium Whole Earth Catalog has been touted as "the ultimate toolbox for independent living," and, according to Kirkus Reviews, is the "coolest Yellow Pages around." The catalog is a source book for future trends and expertise in fields ranging from sexuality, alternative health and information technology, to household needs, education and responsible investing.

Rheingold is the author of The Virtual Community: Homesteading on the Electronic Frontier, published in 1993, and Virtual Reality (1991). Rheingold is also the executive editor of HotWired, a multimedia, on-line publication from Wired magazine.
