UCSD WILL PRESENT THE GOLUB-KAPLAN-CARR TRIO DECEMBER 3

Pianist David Golub, violinist Mark Kaplan and cellist Colin Carr comprise the classical piano chamber ensemble Golub-KaplanCarr Trio, which will perform at 8 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 3, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

The program will be Beethoven: E-Flat Variations, Op. 44; Ravel: Piano Trio; and Brahms: Piano Trio in B Major, Op. 8.

Tickets for the event are \$20 general admission and \$10 for students, and may be purchased at the UCSD Price Center Box Office or from TicketMaster outlets.

Prior to forming the trio, the artists had active solo careers. Since the ensemble's debut in 1982 at the Vancouver Symphony's Beethoven Festival, the Golub-Kaplan-Carr Trio has carved a niche for itself among the world's most highly acclaimed piano trios.

San Diego music critic David Gregson wrote, "This awkwardly named chamber group has earned many fans and quite a number of rave reviews. What a fine musical ensemble it is."

David Golub performs widely in Europe. His concert engagements include the London Symphony Orchestra, the London Philharmonic Orchestra, the Rotterdam Philharmonic, Orchestre de Paris, Maggio Musicale in Florence, Italy and the RAI orchestras in Rome and Milan. He has played recitals in Belgium, Holland and Italy, and for several years performed with Isaac Stern.

Mark Kaplan has appeared with the most prestigious orchestras in the United States and Europe, including the Los Angeles Philharmonic, England's London Symphony and Royal Philharmonic orchestras, and the Berlin Philharmonic.

Colin Carr has appeared as soloist with many symphonies worldwide, including the Amsterdam Philharmonic, the Netherlands Chamber Orchestra and the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande. He is the only British cellist to win first prize in the Naumberg International Cello Competition.
