

National Science Foundation awards UCSD two research grants to total \$216,100.

Two research grants totaling \$216,100 have been awarded the University of California, San Diego, by the National Science Foundation, Washington, D.C.

One grant, for \$149,600, covers support of research entitled, "Regulatory if Mechanisms in Meiosis and Mitosis," to be conducted under the direction of Dr. Herbert Stern, professor of biology.

The second award, for \$66,500, will support research entitled, "Sedimentation, Morphology, and Structure of Small Portions of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge," to be conducted under the direction of Dr. Tjeerd H. Van Andel, research geologist and lecturer in oceanography at the University's Scripps Institution of Oceanography.
