

Four public members elected to three-year terms on Board of Trustees of the UCSD Foundation

They are Robert B. Ballantyne, Los Angeles attorney; Jack H. McDonald, recently retired president and chairman of the board of the Imperial Corporation of America, San Diego; Frank L. Hope Jr., San Diego architect, and Eben W. Dobson Jr., regional vice president of Investors Diversified Services Inc. and a past president of the San Diego Chamber of Commerce.

The appointments expand the size of the board from five to nine members. Currently serving on the board are University of California, San Diego administrators Dr. William D. McElroy, chancellor and board president; Dr. Clifford Grobstein, vice chancellor - university relations, and Dr. William A. Nierenberg, vice chancellor - marine sciences, both vice presidents; Dr. John H. Moxley III, vice chancellor - health sciences, trustee; Bernard Siscos vice chancellor - administration, secretary-treasurer, and Robert H. Smith, assistant to the chancellor - alumni and development, executive director.

Formed last December, the foundation is a means through which the San Diego campus can accept private gifts while providing local control and management of development funds. It was established in response to the university's recognition that private support must be encouraged if UCSD is to maintain quality and a position of eminence among institutions of higher learning.
