

Hellman Faculty Fellowships Awarded to eight At UCSD

Eight promising assistant professors at the University of California, San Diego are the recipients of a total \$120,000 in Hellman Faculty Fellowships for 1996-97.

The Hellman Family Foundation of San Francisco established the Hellman Fellows program to support and encourage young faculty in the core disciplines. Two-thirds of the available funds were designated for research in the physical sciences, life sciences and engineering, and one-third in the arts, humanities and social sciences.

A total \$2.5 million was donated last year, the first in the program, to cover a 10 year period.

This year's awardees include Sheldon Brown, Visual Arts; Lisa Catanzarite, Sociology; Patricia Jennings, Chemistry/Biochemistry; Shirley McGuire, Psychology; Scott Renn, Physics; Ulrike Schaede, International Relations/Pacific Studies; Yitzhak Tor, Chemistry/Biochemistry, and Kenneth Yun, Electrical and Computer Engineering.
