BY Virtue of the Power and Authority to Me derived, from His Most Excellent Majesty, GEORGE the Second of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland King, and of Jamaica Lord, Defender of the Faith, &c. and reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Experience, Courage, Conduct, Fidelity and Skill in military Affairs, I have constituted and appointed, and by these Presents do Constitute and appoint you the said Thomas Hall to be Lieutenant Colonel of the Western division of Horse raised in

this Island whereof the Hon^{ble} Brigadier General Norwood Miller is Colonel

You are therefore as Lieut ^{Colonel} to take the said Regiment into your Care and Charge, and duly to exercise the inferior Officers and Troopers thereof in Arms, and to use your best Endeavours to keep them in good Order and Discipline, and all inferior Officers and Troopers belonging to the said Regiment are hereby strictly commanded to obey you as their Lieut ^{Colonel} and you are to observe and follow all such Orders and Directions as you shall from Time to Time receive from His Majesty, Myself, or other your superior Officers, according to the Rules of War, and the Trust reposed in you.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at St. Jago de la Vega the 25th Day of November
in the Thirtieth Year of His Majesty's Reign, Annoq; Domini, 1756.
