

## Volunteers needed to tutor foreign scholars

Volunteers are needed to tutor foreign scholars and their families in the American English in Action program at the University of California, San Diego.

The program, sponsored by the UC San Diego Office of International Education, provides English instruction to visitors from more than 25 countries, though most requests for tutors come from Chinese and Japanese scholars.

Tutors are not required to know the language of the students. A sensitivity to the basic communication needs of the students and a command of standard English are desired. Tutors meet with their students once a week either at the International Center on the university campus or at the home of either participant.
