UCSD TO HOST ANNUAL PREVIEW DAY OCTOBER 3

More than 5,000 prospective college students from throughout the western U.S. are expected to take a firsthand look at the University of California, San Diego, during the annual Preview Day slated Oct. 3 on the La Jolla campus.

The event precedes the Nov. 1-30, 1992 filing period for UC applications, the only time applications from prospective freshmen will be accepted for the 1993 fall quarter.

Because of the large number of students and their families expected to attend, identical Preview Day presentations are being offered at 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Visitors may select the session that best fits their schedules.

The Preview Day program includes presentations on admissions, financial aid and housing, a student panel discussion, campus tours, and an information fair featuring UCSD's academic departments, campus life programs and student organizations. Additionally, two special sessions for transfer students from California community colleges are planned.

The informational day for prospective students is sponsored by the Student Outreach and Recruitment (SOAR) Office in conjunction with the UCSD Associated Student Government.
