Sunday's dinner is the second in a series of international dinners planned to raise funds for the Center and also to introduce the International Center to the San Diego community. Future plans include an African dinner, a near-eastern dinner, a Jewish dinner, and a French dinner.

Proceeds from the dinner will be used to help furnish the Center's kitchen and to raise funds for a matching grant earmarked for furnishing and landscaping the Center.
