

## Smetana Quartet will perform

## October 29, 1966

The first two performances of the 1966-1967 Chamber Music Series sponsored by the University of California, San Diego will be presented by the Smetana Quartet of Prague, Czechoslovakia. They will perform at 8:00 p.m., Thursday, November 3, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium on the UCSD campus, and at 8:30 p.m., Friday, November 4, in Sherwood Hall, La Jolla.

Tickets for both performances are \$3.00 for the general public and \$1.00 for UCSD students. They are available through the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures at 453-2000, extension 1391.

On Thursday night the Quartet will perform Quartet in F major, Op. 96 by Dvorak; Quartet number I by Janacek; and Quartet number 1 in E minor by Smetana. On Friday the Quartet will perform Quartet number 5 in D, Op. 64 by Haydn; Quartet number 4 by Martinu; and Quartet in B flat, Op. 130. The final selection by Beethoven will be the original version which, for the finale, includes the Great Fugue in B flat, Op. 133.
