

Dr. Martin N. Chamberlain's title changed to Dean of University Extension

Dr. Martin N. Chamberlain, Director of University Extension at the University of California, San Diego since January, 1966, has had his title changed to Dean of University Extension in order to better emphasize the academic role of University Extension.

The University has recently begun to examine the desirability of offering degree programs for part-time students through University Extension.

A professional adult educator with broad academic and administrative experience, Dr. Chamberlain served as Director of the Peace Corps in Tanzania, East Africa, for two years prior to his UCSD position. He received a B.S. degree in Mining Engineering and Geology from the University of Washington in 1936 and a Ph.D. from the Division of Social Sciences of the University of Chicago in 1960.
