

Chairman of UCSD will speak on "Ecology of Communities"

The Chairman of the University of California's Department of Oceanography will speak on "The Ecology of Communities" in a free public lecture in La Jolla on Tuesday night, January 15.

E. W. Fager; Associate Professor of Biology, will give one of the Faculty Lectures co-sponsored by the University's San Diego campus and the Theatre and-Arts Foundation of San Diego County. The event will be held at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, at 8:00 p.m. The public is invited. Admission is free.

A Californian by birth, Dr. Fager holds a Ph.D. in organic chemistry from Yale, a D. Phil. in zoology from Oxford. He came to the Scripps Institution of Oceanography in 1956. His special field of study is population dynamics.

His talk will deal with populations in nature. He will discuss what happens when man disrupts the animal community.
