U.S. practices at Guantanamo Bay and Abu Ghraib and other human rights issues will be discussed by investigative journalist Mark Danner when he speaks on *"Into the Light of Day: Torture, Human Rights and Bush's State of Exception"* at 6 p.m. Feb. 15 in the Price Center Ballroom at the University of California, San Diego.
