

Nelson Fuller appointed publications manager of UCSD

Nelson Fuller, former resident of San Diego, has been appointed publications manager for the University of California, San Diego.

Fuller joined UCSD after 4 1/2 years at Rotary International's 2 central office, Evanston, Ill., more recently as editor of the seven language publication, R. I. News, and of Rotary's annual convention bulletin.

He served 16 years in publications and public information for General Dynamics Corporation at Fort Worth, Tex., and in San Diego. Prior to that he was a wire editor in the Texas bureau of The Associated Press, Dallas, and editor of the Nacogdoches (Texas) Daily Sentinel.

A native of LaFayette, Ind., Fuller is a journalism graduate of the University of Texas. He is a member of Sigma Delta Chi, professional journalistic society, and of the Rotary Club of Pacific Beach, where he and his family will reside.
