

Exhibit of abstract paintings by three Los Angeles artists at UCSD Art Gallery

Abstract paintings by three Los Angeles artists will be exhibited through Feb. 15 at the UCSD Art Gallery on the Revelle Campus of the University of California, San Diego.

The artists, Tom Holland, Edward Moses and Richard Yokomi, all utilize unusual forms and mediums in their work.

Holland rivets plastic shapes to a plastic background on which he has painted similar shapes. Moses works on canvas which he presents off the stretcher and immersed in plastic. Unstretched canvas is also used by Yokomi who cuts out free-form shapes and assembles them.

Hours for the gallery, located in 1260 Humanities-Library Building, are noon to 5 p.m. daily and 8 to 10 p.m. Wednesday.
