UCSD TO HOLD TOWN MEETING OCT. 28 ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT

The University of California, San Diego Women's Center will hold a town meeting Monday, Oct. 28 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 108, Peterson Hall on "Sexual Harassment: A Very Personal National Issue."

The town meeting will feature a panel discussion moderated by Chandra Mukerji, chair of the UCSD Chancellor's Advisory Committee on the Status of Women and a professor in the Communication Dept. The panelists will include: University of San Diego Law Professor Roy Brooks, who will discuss legal aspects of sexual harassment in the workplace; UCSD Political Science Professor Steve Erie, whose remarks will focus on the current gender climate in Washington, D.C.; Dr. Lisa Hirschman, a psychologist experienced in treating the psychological consequences of sexual abuse; and Ms. Nancy Wahlig, a counselor with UCSD's Student Safety Awareness Program, who counsels students who have been victims of sexual harassment.

Admittance to the town meeting is \$5.00 for the general public and \$2.00 for students. Parking permits are also required and can be purchased for \$2.00 at the Gilman and Northview Drive entrances to the campus. All proceeds from the town meeting will be donated to the UCSD Women's Center.
