

The Regents accepted gifts and pledges of \$58,749 for the San Diego campus during the past month

The Regents of the University of California have accepted gifts and pledges of \$58,749 for the San Diego campus during the past month. Aside from \$400 given by an anonymous donor, the funds come from U. S. Government agencies. They are:

From the National Institutes of Health, \$500 to support studies of mutant algae for studies of photosynthetic pigments by Dr. Jean H. Foley under the direction of Dr. Francis T. Haxo, Associate Professor of Marine Biology.

Also from the National Institutes of Health, \$4,449 to support studies of the effect of organic substances from the sea on bacteria, by Dr. Galen E. Jones, Assistant Research Microbiologist.

From the National Science Foundation, \$53,400 for the partial support of an expedition this fall designed to conduct studies of the Cromwell Current by Dr. John A. Knauss, Associate Research Oceanographer.
