

Drawings and painting by Sandra Woodward Baltimore on display in Library Gallery

An exhibition of drawings and one painting by artist Sandra Woodward Baltimore is currently being shown in the Library Gallery in Building B at the University of California, San Diego. The exhibit, open to the public at no cost, will remain through October 16.

Mrs. Baltimore, born in 1941, recently moved to San Diego from New York where she studied under Sidney Gross and Will Barnet of the Art Student's League. She has also studied with Carl von Volborth of Cincinnati. She graduated from Swarthmore College in 1963 and has taught drawing, painting and metalwork in New York and Connecticut.

Mrs. Baltimore was represented by the Waverly Gallery in New York City. She is married to David Baltimore, a research biologist at the Salk Institute for Biological Studies.
