MILLIONAIRE MOOCHERS ARE STILL AT IT!

DURING THE PAST YEAR, SCHURZ'S PROSTITUTED PRESS WITH NEWSPAPERS IN EL CENTRO, BRAWLEY, AND INDIO, ALL IN IMPERIAL & COACHELLA VALLEYS IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, HAS BEEN BRAINWASHING THE PEOPLE TO BELIEVE THAT THE POOR ON WELFARE ARE THE CAUSE OF HIGH TAXES HERE.

This brainwashing has been done by articles in the general columns but particularly by planted letters in the VOICE OF THE PEOPLE and PROBE written by Mike James which is supposed to answer inquiries from the readers.

IN A NEWSLETTER DATED AUGUST 20, 1963, AND ENTITLED "HOW THE POOR ARE KEPT POOR", IT WAS SHOWN THAT THE WEALTHY BIG RANCHERS AND LAND-OWNERS COLLECTED 8 TIMES MORE CHARITY THAN THE INDIGENT POOR. SO IT IS ONCE AGAIN NECESSARY TO GIVE YOU THE FACTS THAT THE BIG RANCHERS COLLECT ABOUT EIGHT TIMES MORE (CALLED BY FANCY NAMES LIKE SUBSIDIES, PRICE SUPPORTS, PAYMENTS FOR LAND WITHDRAWAL, ETC. TO FOOL YOU, AND FAKE LOW ASSESSMENTS ON FARMLAND, LOW IRRIGATION WATER RATES, ETC.) THAN THE POOR THAT LIVE IN THESE TWO VALLEYS WHOSE CHARITY IS PUBLICIZED.

Schurz's Prostituted Press gets its payoffs from the big ranchers in the form of advertisements of fertilizers, insecticides, farm machinery, etc. Schurz's daily newspapers wanted Raymond I. Seeley, a Republican from Blythe, Calif. who was running for Assemblyman of the 75th District against Susan Marx in the Nov. 3, 1970 election. In the month preceding the election, letters were planted in PROBE every few days in which a supposed reader asks a question about some drunk or some woman with several children living with a man not her husband, all of whom are on welfare. Then PROBE would give the answer supposedly after an investigation.

Two or three days afterwards, there would be a big advertisement in SCHURZ'S PROSTITUTED PRESS put in by Seeley. This ad would show a facsimile of PROBE with the question and answer. Now it must be realized that 90% of the voters are in the yearly income group of \$4,000.00 to \$10,000.00. Now the people on welfare usually get up to \$4,000.00 a year depending on the number of children-- a woman with 10 children gets \$4,000.00 yearly. But I am a physician who still makes home calls to patients and I have visited many homes of people on welfare. I HAVE NEVER SEEN ANY WOMAN GET RICH HAVING BABIES!!!

Raymond Seeley in his ad with PROBE would claim he was going to stop "this welfare swindling". People earning \$4,000.00 to \$10,000.00 yearly work hard for their money and pay heavy taxes. They are just one step ahead on the economic ladder than the people on welfare. SO THEY GET VERY ANGRY TO LEARN THAT THERE IS SOME WELFARE SWINDLING.

But PROBE never prints letters inquiring how big a charity handout certain big ranchers get. If such letters had been printed, Susan Marx would have won for the voters would have found out that in Imperial County in 1970, the big ranchers got \$12 millions in charity handouts (subsidies, price supports, payments for land withdrawal alone-not including the taxes they escape with the fake low assessments and the fake low irrigation water charges) AS COMPARED TO THE POOR WHO GOT ONLY \$6.5 MILLIONS.

Readers should know that these big ranchers get handouts for growing crops and FOR NOT GROWING CROPS. In the 1930's, both Hitler and Mussolini gave money to women to have more babies. They wanted more men for the coming wars, so that both these leaders of countries wanted more infants. The babies born in the United States and supported by welfare will be the soldiers in future wars that the U.S. engages in. As a matter of fact, the U.S. has been at war in one form or another since 1940. So you complainers about women having babies on welfare must consider this--women like farmers grow crops, crops of children!

About one month ago, a COUNTY SERVICES BUILDING was opened at El Centro, Calif. A good portion of this building is occupied by the Imperial County Welfare Dept. since January 1971. Since then a flood of planted letters have appeared in PROBE with answers to make the citizens believe that everyone on welfare is swindling. Mike James, the former N.Y. Times reporter (why did he leave the N.Y. Times?) with his column PROBE has called this building HANDOUT HOUSE repeatedly. This is just propaganda full of lies to distract the attention of the citizens from the real handout place, HANDOUT HEAVEN where the big farmers get the big handouts disguised by fancy names like price supports, subsidies, payments for land withdrawal, payments for growing sugar, etc.

HANDOUT HEAVEN IS LOCATED AT 300 SOUTH IMPERIAL AVE. EL CENTRO, WHERE UNDER THE FANCY NAME OF AGRICULTURAL STABILIZATION AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE TO FOOL YOU, \$12 MILLIONS YEARLY ARE BEING GIVEN TO WEALTHY BIG RANCHERS WHO HAVE MANSIONS, CADILLACS EACH YEAR, AIRPLANES, TRIPS TO EUROPE, ASIA, AFRICA, ETC. THIS MONEY COMES FROM YOUR TAXES.

The Welfare Dept. gives its money to people to have food, clothing and a place to live. All the money the poor on welfare receive, IS SPENT HERE!!!. Many merchants, landlords, and others doing business with the poor WOULD GO BROKE WITHOUT THE MONEY THAT THE POOR SPEND WITH THEM. 70% of the land is owned by outsiders like the Irvine Co., Purex Co., Dow Chemical Co., S.P. Land Co., Tenneco, Inc., Kaiser Aluminum Co., H.P. Murphy Co., etc. Most of the handouts given out at HANDOUT HEAVEN by this Committee whose correct official name should be CHARITY COMMITTEE FOR NEEDY FARMERS, leaves this area AND IS NOT SPENT ONCE HERE.

Do not forget that these same big farmers also get a handout of \$14 millions yearly in cheap irrigation water given them by the Imperial Irrigation District while you residents of Imperial & Coachella Valleys are forced to pay 3 times the correct price for electricity to subsidize these big absentee farmers and landowners. There are many other handouts as the big landowners escaping 66% of their correct property taxes by fake low assessments, etc. but there is not enough space to tell it all. Other Newsletters will tell these other handouts.

The audacity of these big farmers in trying to fool the people is tremendous. On Feb. 9, 1971, SCHURZ'S PROSTITUTED PRESS for which Mike James writes, printed a VOICE OF THE PEOPLE LETTER signed by John H. Borchard of 1425 South Cypress Ave. El Centro. Now this man is only half a millionaire but he has a loud mouth. His letter reads, "The reason the High School tax override lost the last election is because people are fed up with being overtaxed. Maybe if we were allowed to vote against unjustified welfare, we would be a little more inclined to pass a school tax, etc. etc. etc."

The Federal Government records show that in 1967, John H. Borchard was paid \$46,369 for NOT GROWING COTTON. In succeeding years, he received similar handouts. THIS MONEY BORCHARD RECEIVES FROM US TAXPAYERS. He is paid for doing nothing! So what is he raving about? He probably pays no Federal or State income taxes and if he does, they are most likely below \$1,000.00 yearly. His land escapes about 66% of the property taxes. FRANKLY SPEAKING, JOHN H. BORCHARD PAYS NO TAXES WHEN COMPARED TO THE BIG HANDOUTS HE IS GIVEN. Yet he has the COLOSSAL GALL to write letters attacking the small handouts given to people so that they should not starve to death, have some clothes, and a place to live.

By law, the records of the Welfare Dept. are closed to inspection. But a woman with 10 children gets about \$4,000.00. By law, the records at HANDOUT HEAVEN are open to the public. Why does not Mike James go to HANDOUT HEAVEN and then print how big the handout LOUDMOUTH BORCHARD GETS OR THE OTHER BIG RANCHERS GET? He will lose his job if he did. Because the local newspapers would not print my letters to the Editor telling the truth, I started these Newsletters so you learn the truth.
