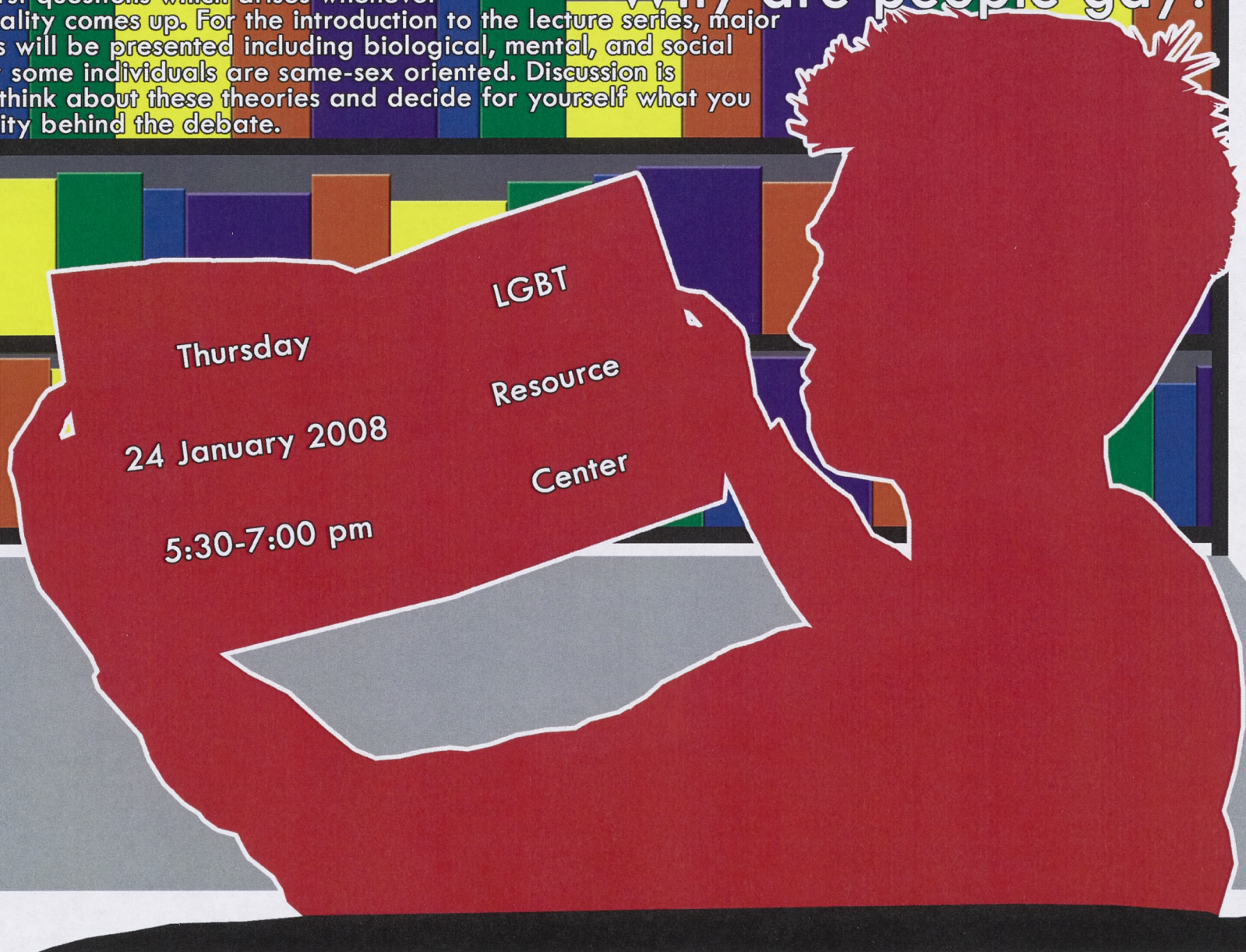

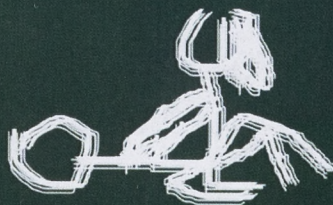
"Sex Education: What they did not teach on in Middle School"

Sex Education is a program intended to promote sex-positive discussion and the exploration of sexuality. Most sex education programs in primary and secondary schools provide a watered-down version simply promoting abstinence from a hetero-normative view. This program will promote sex-positive Sex Ed and include a discussion which will display the unique experiences of several generations and the LGBT community. The Rubber Rose will be doing a short presentation on anatomy that is pleasure-based and an inclusive discussion will follow. After the discussion, participants will join in a collaborative zine that detail their sex education experience that will later be distributed.

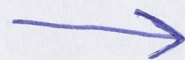
