

Dr. William Nachbar takes leave to lecture in Israel

Dr. William Nachbar, professor of applied mechanics at UCSD, will spend the month of March in Haifa, Israel as a visiting professor at the Technion-Israel Institute of Technology. Nachbar, who will be on leave of absence from UCSD for the period, will lecture on static and dynamic stability of structures.

During his stay in Israel, Nachbar also will take part in panel discussions at the 12th Israel Conference on Aviation and Astronautics.

Nachbar joined the UCSD faculty in 1965. He is an authority on the structural integrity of space-vehicle "shells" and is also well-known for his work on the burning mechanism of solid propellants.

In 1967, Nachbar was awarded a Guggenheim Foundation fellowship for studies in Denmark and Holland.

Nachbar received his Ph.D. in applied mathematics from Brown University in 1951. His wife, Pauline, also holds a doctorate from Brown in the same field.

The Nachbars reside in La Jolla.
