

Ambassador Jaipal, representative of India to UN to speak

Ambassador Rikhi Jaipal, permanent representative of India to the United Nations, will speak at the International Center on the University of California, San Diego campus Wednesday, Jan. 21, at 7:30 p.m. His speech, entitled, "So-called Tyranny of the Majority in the United Nations," is open to the public with no admission charge.

Ambassador Jaipal has been in the Indian Diplomatic Service since 1948. He has served in India's ministry of External Affairs and as an ambassador to Yugoslavia, Greece and Austria. He is currently India's permanent representative to the International Atomic Energy Agency and a member of its board of governors, as well as a UN representative.
