

Dr. Harold C. Urey receives the Medal of the University of Paris

Harold C. Urey, Professor of Chemistry at Large, University of California, was presented with the Medal of the University of Paris in the Great Hall of the Sorbonne in Paris recently.

Dr. Urey, who makes his home in La Jolla, was attending the International Conference on Nuclear Physics. He spoke at a special session in commemoration of the 30th anniversary of the discovery of artificial radioactivity by Irene and Frederic Joliot-Curie.

Others receiving the medal at the same time were Professor Francis Perrin of Paris, Professor D. V. Skobeltzyn of Moscow, and Professor E. Amaldi of Rome.
