COMPLAINT

ON THE ABOVE TIME AND DATE, I WAS COOKING DINNER WHEN I NOTICED A BUNCH OF <sup>PEOPLE</sup> HURRYING AROUND MY FRONT YARD, WHICH I COULD SEE FROM MY KITCHEN. AS I WALKED TOWARD THE LIVING ROOM TO SEE, AND TO CHECK ON MY CHILDREN, THE DOOR SUDDENLY WAS KICKED OPEN BY SOMEONE AND SEVERAL MEN RUSHED INTO THE HOUSE YELLING, "NARCOS, GET OUT OF THE WAY". I BARELY HAD TIME TO GRAB MY BABIES WHO ARE 4 AND 5 YEARS OLD. AND MY GIRL WHO IS 7 YEARS OLD. THE CHILDREN BEGAN SCREAMING AND YELLING. THE 5 YEAR OLD RAN AND LOCKED HIMSELF IN THE BATHROOM. I WAS IN SHOCK AND TERRIBLY AFRAID FOR OUR LIVES. THE <sup>MEAN</sup> MEN KEPT ASKING "WHERE ARE THE DRUGS, DO YOU TAKE DRUGS?" THEY ASKED A LOT OF QUESTIONS AND LOOKED AROUND ASKING WHO ELSE WAS IN THE HOUSE. FINALLY, THEY REALIZED THEY HAD THE WRONG HOUSE, BUT, BY THEN THE CHILDREN WERE INCONSOLABLE AND I WAS A NERVOUS WRECK AND COULDN'T STOP

SHAKING. I AM VERY UPSET AND MY CHILDREN CAN-  
NOT SLEEP AND THEY RUN AND HIDE WHEN SOMEONE  
COMES TO THE DOOR. 2 WEEKS EARLIER SOME  
MEN AND A WOMAN BROKE INTO MY HOUSE WHILE  
WE WERE THERE AND TOOK MY T.D. THERE ARE SO  
MANY DRUG DEALERS IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD, YET  
THE POLICE CHOOSE MY HOUSE TO RAID. THEY  
FIXED MY DOOR, BUT WHO IS GOING TO FIX  
THE DAMAGE TO ME, AND ESPECIALLY MY  
CHILDREN.

From August 22, 1987 to September 22nd, 1987, The Coalition For Law & Justice filed (5) complaints of assaults by San Diego Police Department officers. They were filed with S.D.P.D. with copies to City Manager [REDACTED], Chairman of the Citizen's Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations, City Councilwoman [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Director of the Chicano Federation. The complaints were filed in this manner to show, not only the violent nature of these assaults, but, also our opposition to the recently un-empowered Citizens Advisory Board on police practices. Also, to underscore our continuing contention that a police controlled review board, with no power, is no different and no better than what we already have- police investigating police.

We have enclosed copies of the complaints for purposes of illustrating the gravity of the situation as well as the state of police/community relations, which along with the confidence in the police complaint process are at an all time low.

ENCLOSED YOU WILL ALSO FIND COMPLAINTS AND NEWSPAPER ARTICLES EXPOSING A SERIOUS SERIES OF BUNGLED DRUG RAIDS BY SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT NARCOTIC TASK FORCE OFFICERS ON THE WRONG HOUSES. THE AMATEUR AND INCOMPETENT MANNER IN WHICH THESE DRUG RAIDS ARE BEING CONDUCTED ARE, AND CONTINUE, TO EXPOSE INNOCENT PEOPLE TO LIFE THREATENING SITUATIONS AND PSYCHOLOGICAL DAMAGE.

MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN ARE TERRORIZED WITH GUNS, DOORS AND WINDOWS ARE BROKEN DOWN AND FURNITURE AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS ARE EITHER DESTROYED OR THROWN ABOUT.

THE PHYSICAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY CAN BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED — WHAT CAN'T BE REPAIRED SO EASILY IS THE PSYCHOLOGICAL DAMAGE TO WOMEN AND CHILDREN. THE SCARS REMAIN LONG AFTER THE CLEAN UP.

ACCORDING TO A STATEMENT TO ME BY SGT. [REDACTED], EXTENSIVE SURVEILLANCE AND "BUYS" ARE MADE AT THE SUSPECTED DRUG HOUSES OVER A LONG PERIOD OF TIME. SO WHY ARE SUCH SERIOUS MISTAKES MADE?
