UCSD CHANCELLOR RECEIVES HONORARY DEGREE

Richard C. Atkinson, chancellor of the University of California, San Diego, will be awarded an honorary degree of Doctor of Science by the University of North Carolina at Greensboro during May 17 commencement ceremonies.

Atkinson, who has received honorary Doctor of Science degrees from more than a dozen other American universities, has served as chancellor at UCSD since 1980. Prior to his UC appointment he was director of the National Science Foundation. He is past president of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, and is current chairman of the Association of American Universities.

The University of North Carolina will celebrate its 100th commencement at the May 17 ceremonies.
