

## Veteran employees to receive awards

A service awards program honoring 56 veteran employees of the University of California, San Diego will be held at 3:00 p.m., Friday, June 2, in the auditorium of the Humanities-Library Building in Revelle College on the campus.

UCSD Chancellor John S. Galbraith will serve as host for the annual event. The employees to be honored this year will be welcomed by Mr. Dale Cobb, UCSD Personnel Manager, and service-award pins and retirement certificates will be presented by Chancellor Galbraith. The ceremony will be followed by refreshments served in the ground-level West Court area of the three-story building.

For the first time, employees at the County-University Hospital will be included in the awards ceremony. This year three UCSD employees will receive retirement certificates. They are: Benjamin C. Green, of La Jolla, a custodian with the Physical Plant who retired April 28 after 21 and a half years of service; Miss Dorothy A. Kellar, of La Jolla, a principal clerk in the Department of Marine Biology who will retire July 31 after 15 years of service; and Clarence A. Pfankuch, of San Diego, a second officer with Marine Facilities who retired last December 30 after 14 years of service.

Two employees will receive 25 year awards and certificates. They are Mrs. Frances E. Maloney, of San Diego, an administrative assistant with the Visibility Laboratory; and John B. Stackelberg, Route 1, Del Mar, a senior maintenance man with the Physical Plant.

In addition, 7 employees will receive awards for 20 years of service, 10 will receive awards for 15 years of service, and 34 will receive awards for 10 years of service. A list of award winners, their title and department follows:
