UCSD GOSPEL CHOIR TO PERFORM NOVEMBER 26

Traditional and modern gospel songs will be performed by about 300 members of the 900-member University of California, San Diego Gospel Choir at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 26 in the UCSD Mandeville Auditorium.

Some of the selections the chorus will sing are "The Potter's House," led by singers Mia Garrett and David Breland, and "Feel the Spirit" led by singer Karen Barnett. Other selections will include "Oh Lord We Praise You," "All in Favor," and "That Kind of Friend."

Greg Sephus will accompany the chorus on the organ and chorus director Ken Anderson will accompany on piano.

Anderson said the complete 900-voice chorus will perform in a spring concert at Camp Pendleton, Oceanside, as well as at Balboa Park's Organ Pavilion. "Because of the size of the full chorus, it's difficult to perform on most stages. We look forward to performing at venues where the entire complement of voices can sing," he said.
