

Bicyclists at UCSD will join with community cyclists in a ride as part of festivities for "Bike for a Better San Diego"

Bicyclists at the University of California, San Diego will join with community cyclists in a ride from UCSD's Revelle College Plaza to the Community Concourse as part of festivities for "Bike for a Better San Diego" Day, Wednesday, October 25.

Declared "Bike Day" by the San Diego City Council, it is hoped that the events planned will give the City an indication of the number of people who already have bikes and who want to bicycle as a means of transportation. The day also will be used to encourage others to use bicycles and motivate the City Council to implement bicycle lanes around the City.

Riders also will be leaving from other points in the City. One group is scheduled to leave from the Ford Building in Balboa Park at 7:30 a.m. on a ride to the Community Concourse before work. Another is scheduled to leave California State University, San Diego at 3 p.m. and meet with UCSD and other participants at the Concourse at 4 p.m.

The UCSD ride will begin at approximately 2 p.m. Distinguished participants include Dr. Clifford L. Graves, a physician and avid bicyclist in La Jolla, and honorary chairman of "Bike for a Better San Diego"; Professor Andrew Wright, Chairman, Literature Department; Professor Jef Raskin, Visual Arts Department; Dr. Ted Forbes, Chairman, Physical Education Department; Professor Peter Farrell, Music Department, and Mr. Walter Schmitt, UCSD's Scripps Institution of Oceanography Marine Life Resources Division.

The detailed route from La Jolla to San Diego with stops at La Jolla High School, Mission Bay High School and the McDonald's Restaurant in Pacific Beach, follows: Leave UCSD's Revelle College Plaza at approximately 2 to 2:15 p.m.; proceed down La Jolla Shores Drive past Scripps Institution of Oceanography; make a right onto De La Playa; make a left onto Calle De La Plata; make a right onto Paseo Dorado; Paseo Dorado becomes Spindrift and then Princess; from Princess turn right onto Torrey Pines Road.

Go west on Torrey Pines Road and make a left onto Girard; make a right onto Pearl; make a left onto Fay; continue on Fay to Nautilus; make a right onto Nautilus and stop for students at La Jolla High School at approximately 2:45 p.m..

Continue down Nautilus and make a left onto La Jolla Blvd.; proceed south on La Jolla Blvd. which turns into Loring at the corner of Mission Blvd.; continue three blocks on Loring (going east) and make a right turn onto Dawes; continue down Dawes and stop at the McDonald's Restaurant at the corner of Dawes and Garnet at approximately 3 p.m.

Proceed on Dawes one block and make a left on Hornblend; continue east on Hornblend and make a right onto Noyes and then a left onto Grand; proceed down Grand and stop at Mission Bay High School at approximately 3:15 p.m.

Continue east on Grand and make a right onto Mission Bay Drive; proceed down Mission Bay Drive and make a right onto Sea World Drive; then make a left onto Pacific Highway; proceed along Pacific Highway into

San Diego to Ash Street; make a left onto Ash and then a right onto Kettner Blvd.; make a left onto C Street and proceed up C Street to the Community Concourse at approximately 4 p.m.
