

50th Annual UCSD Math Contest Will Showcase Talented San Diego Students

The 50th annual UCSD High School Honors Math Contest will be held on Saturday, April 21, with some 150 students from 25 San Diego high schools competing for mathematical mastery.

Student contestants will complete two hour-and-half exams consisting of multiple-choice and written problems, covering all high-school mathematics topics through pre-calculus and trigonometry.

Sponsored by UC San Diego, the Greater San Diego Math Council, and the San Diego County Office of Education, the contest will begin at 7:45 a.m. in Peterson Hall of Thurgood Marshall College on the UCSD campus.

Winners of the contest, both individuals and teams, will be honored at an Awards Banquet on Tuesday, May 1, at UCSD's Faculty Club.
