The public is invited to attend and learn first hand about life in the Soviet Union from a group of visiting ordinary Soviet citizens. The event is one of several planned by the San Diego branch of the "Soviets, Meet Middle America" group. All expenses are being paid by contributions from the community. The Soviets will be guests in area homes and will also visit other American cities as part of a larger national program. The Soviet visitors will speak about their impressions of America and answer questions about their homeland. Mary Dhooge, Dean of International Education and Director of the International Center will preside over the program. Lee Tablewski, vice president of the San Diego World Affairs Council will moderate the round table discussion. Karl Amotneek will be the interpreter.
