BACKGROUND: The four undergraduate colleges and the graduate studies program at the University of California, San Diego will hold individual graduation ceremonies on the campus Sunday, June 17, 1984. Times and locations for the ceremonies are as follows:

Muir College, 9:30 a.m. on the lawn between Third College and Mandeville Center. Some 647 students are eligible to take part. Speaker: Rolf Benirschke, San Diego Chargers.

Warren College, 10:30 a.m. on the lawn south of the Humanities-Library Building. Some 561 students are eligible to take part. Speaker: Z Kripke, M.D., Student Health Center.

Graduate Division, noon in the Mandeville Center Auditorium. About 80 graduates are expected to take part with hooding of Ph.D. and Master of Fine Arts candidates as part of the ceremony. Speaker: Arnold Mandell, M.D., UCSD Department of Psychiatry.

Revelle College, 2 p.m. on the lawn south of the Humanities-Library Building. Some 365 students are eligible to take part. Speaker: Dr. Chia-Wei Woo, president, San Francisco State University.

Third College, 3 p.m. on the lawn between Third College and the Mandeville Center. Some 410 students are eligible to take part. Speaker: University of California Vice President of Academic Affairs Dr. William R. Frazer.
