DESCRIPTION: The University Art Gallery exhibition is a virtual reality, interactive exhibition; the CRCA exhibition is an outdoor exhibit and uses elevated video monitors (best viewed after dark, as images are projected onto sidewalk below); Birch Aquarium Museum exhibition is a site-specific sculpture (non-mobile); The VA Hospital exhibit is non-mobile, and is made up of larger-than-life cut-out drawings of patients who have taken part in the project); UCSD Visual Arts Center Gallery exhibit has a series of dioramas and digitized photos which present a history of turn-of-the-century San Diego.
