BACKGROUND: Three faculty members of the UCSD Department of Music, Robert Erickson, Roger Reynolds and Bernard Rands, are scheduled to take part in a major concert of their new works February 22 at UCSD. The world premiere of "Taffytime" by Erickson, the American premiere of "Archipelago" by Reynolds, and the chamber version of "Canti del Sole" by Rands will be presented in the Mandeville Auditorium.

The three artists, all of whom have gained international recognition as composers of contemporary music, will be available to discuss and to demonstrate their music on February 7. Their works are being performed in major music centers of the world and they have each received several notable awards.
