BACKGROUND: "The History of Houses Without Walls" is a 24-hour musical event, conceived and coordinated by David Dramm, Alexa Henderson and Thea Evans. It begins at 4 p.m. Friday, June 1 and continues to approximately 4 p.m. Saturday, June 2. Fifteen UCSD student musicians will take part in a structured, multi-spaced improvisation. The piece occurs in and around Mandeville Center, often in several places at once. The cavities (stairwells, waterducts, breezeways) of Mandeville will serve as the acoustic spaces which allow listeners to perceive the original music in hundreds of distinct ways. The event is being produced by undergraduates especially for the 1984 Student Arts Festival.
