

UCSD loans a painting by Claude Monet to the Centre Cultural Du Marais for an exhibit in Paris from April 6 through July 17

The University of California, San Diego is loaning a painting by Claude Monet to the Centre Cultural Du Marais for an exhibition opening in Paris on April 6.

Monet's "Effect de Neige A Limetz" ("Impression of Snow at Limetz"), owned by the UCSD Foundation, has been on long-term loan to the San Diego Museum of Art since 1974. It is an oil painting on canvas which Monet created during 1878-1880. The Peterson Silberman Collection donated the painting to the UCSD Foundation in 1973. Since then, it has been exhibited at UCSD, the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, the UC Riverside Art Gallery and the San Diego Museum of Art.

The Brooklyn Museum, the Museum of Modern Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Museums of Fine Art in Boston and Houston, and Smith College are among the other institutions contributing to the Paris exhibition.

"Claude Monet During His Time in Giverny" at the Centre Cultural Du Marais will continue through July 17, 1983.

The UCSD Foundation also owns "Paysage Sous-Bois A Pontoise" by Camille Pissarro, also on loan to the San Diego Museum of Art.
