

Mr. Sam D. Hinton's resignation

Mr. Sam D. Hinton has resigned his position as Senior Museum Scientist at the University of California's Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

He will devote his fall time to concerts, writing, and teaching. Mr. Hinton is a nationally known folksinger and scholar of folklore. He has also written several books in the field of the marine sciences. He is completing the manuscript and illustrations of a book on the intertidal life of southern California. The book will be published by the University of California Press as a part of its new series on southern California natural history. He will continue to teach for University of California Extension.

Mr. Hinton has been associated with Scripps' Thomas Wayland Vaughan Aquarium-Museum since 1946, coming there after two years with the University of California Division of War Research.

He helped design the Aquarium-Museum building and has been responsible for its museum displays.
